Make It Monday #29 Two Cards w/Holly Jolly Wishes & Stitched Star Dies

Holly Jolly Wishes & Stitched Star Dies Evening Evergreen and Soft Succulent CS-5½ x 8½, (card base) Basic White CS-2½ x 3½, 4 x 5¼ (2) Tidings of Christmas DSP-2 x 5¼, 3 x 4 (2) Scraps of Soft Succulent CS-for stars Evening evergreen CS- 2¼ x 5½ & scraps for stars Stitched Star Dies Holly Jolly Wishes Stamp Set Stitched So Sweetly Dies Evening Evergreen Ink Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine Stampin' Seal Adhesive/Liquid Glue Glue Dots Stampin' Dimensionals (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¹/₄. Fold and burnish to create card.
- 2. Use Stampin' Cut n Emboss to crop stars from Evening Evergreen CS and scraps. See video for tip!
- 3. Crop star from Soft Succulent CS
- 4. Card #1: Layer DSP to card front. Stamp greeting on Basic White and crop with Stitched So Sweetly Dies. Add to card front using adhesive or Stampin' Dimensionals. Attach fancy star w/glue dot.
- 5 Card #2: Crop several stars from center of 2 ¼ x 5 ½ strip of Evening Evergreen (see video for tip on saving cardstock. Crop star from Soft Succulent.
- 6. Use Stamparatus to add greeting from Holly Jolly Wishes with Evening Evergreen ink.
- 7. Layer DSP to Evening Evergreen CS and then to left side of card front. Arrange stars as desired and attach using glue dots/adhesive or liquid glue.
- 8. Add Basic White CS to inside and decorate as desired.
