### Butterfly Brilliance Spotlighting

Gorgeous Grape CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base)

Basic Black CS- 3¾ x 5, 2 x 2

Basic White CS- 3½ x 4¾, 4x 5¼

Butterfly Brilliance Stamp Set

Watercolor Pencils

Stamparatus

Layering Circles

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Memento Black Ink

Stampin' Seal Adhesive or Liquid Glue

### Directions-

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Stamp large image for background in Memento Black ink on white CS using the Stamparatus.
3. Use the Layering Circles to cut a circle from the stamped image. Cut one size larger circle from Black CS
4. Color image as desired and mount on Basic Black circle.
5. Attach to card front matching up images.
6. Add white layer to inside and decorate as desired.

### Daisy Garden-Spotlighting

Basic Black CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base), 2 x 2

Daffodil Delight CS-4-1/8x 5-3/8

Basic White CS- 4 x 5¼

Daisy Garden Stamp Set

Stamparatus

Watercolor Pencils

Memento Black Ink

Stampin' Dimensionals

Stampin' Seal Adhesive or Liquid Glue



### Directions-

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Stamp large image for background in Memento Black ink on white CS using the Stamparatus.
3. Use the Layering Circles to cut a circle from the stamped image. Layer two coordinating circles together and cut using Black cardstock. Be sure the dies are nestled flat before running through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine to avoid damaging the dies.
4. Color image as desire, I used watercolor pencils.
5. Attach to circle ring to card and add colored image to inside circle with Stampin' Dimensionals. Be sure to line up stamped images.
6. Add white layer to inside and decorate as desired.

### Flowers of Friendship-Spotlighting

Poppy Parade CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base)

Basic White CS- 4 x 5¼

Friendship of Flowers

Poppy Parade Blend Combo

Old Olive Blend Combo

Memento Black Ink

Stampin' Seal Adhesive or Liquid Glue

### Directions-

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Stamp flowers in layering heights in Memento Black ink on white cardstock panel.
3. Choose one area to color and color with desired tools. I used Poppy Parade & Old Olive Stampin' Blends.
4. Layer white panel to Basic Black CS and then to card front.
4. Layer 4 x 5¼ white panel inside and decorate as desired.

Basic White CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base), 4 x 5¼, 2 x 3

Real Red CS- 4-1/8 x 5-3/8, 2 ½ x 4

Designer Series Paper- 2 x 4

Eclectic Garden Stamp Set

Simply Succulent Stamp Set

1" circle punch

Memento Black Ink

Real Red Stampin' Blends

Stampin' Cut and Emboss Machine

Hippo & Friends Dies

Stampin' Seal Adhesive or Liquid Glue

Stampin' Dimensionals

### Directions:

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Stamp image from Eclectic Garden in Memento Black ink to Real Red CS and Smallest Basic White CS
3. Use Stampin' Blends to color image as shown in video and in photo above.
4. Use the circle punch to punch one area of the image stamped on Real Red CS.
5. Line up images as shown in video and attach with Stampin' Dimensionals. Cut away excess white CS.
6. Attach to card front.
7. Stamp greeting from Simply Succulents in Memento Black ink.
8. Decorate inside as desired.
