



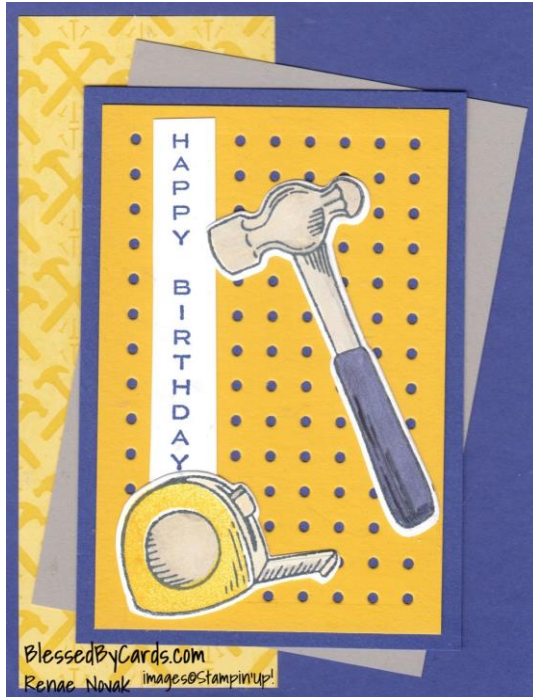

## Make It Monday #141 Trusty Tools Project Sheet



### Trusty Tools Happy Birthday

Starry Sky CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base), 3 x 4

Basic White CS- 3 x 4, 4 x 5¼

Gray Granite CS: 3¼ x 4½

Trusty Toolbox DSP 2 x 5 ¼

Crushed Curry CS: 2 ¾ x 4 1/8

Starry Sky Ink

Memento Black Ink

Crushed Curry Ink

Stampin' Blend Combos: Starry Sky, Crumb Cake,

Gray Granite

Trusty Tools Bundle

So Sincere Stamp Set

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Stampin' Seal Adhesive/Liquid Glue

### Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Add strip of DSP to the left side of card front.
3. Crop the peg board die from the Trusty Tool bundle w/ Crushed Curry CS and attach to Starry Sky panel, then to Gray Granite panel and finally to card front as shown.
4. Stamp hammer and tape measure and color with Stampin' Blends and crop w/ coordinating dies from bundle. See video for details.
5. Stamp greeting from So Sincere and cut to ½ x 3 and attach to card front with tools.
6. Add Basic White CS to the inside and decorate with greeting and wrench. See video for details.

## Make It Monday #141 Trusty Tools Project Sheet



### Trusty Tools Happy Father's Day

Azure Afternoon CS- 5½ x 8½ (card base)

Basic White CS- 3 x 4, 4 x 5¼

Smoky Slate CS: 3 x 4

Trusty Toolbox DSP: 5 1/8 x 4 cut on the diagonal

Pecan Pie CS: 2 ¾ x 4 1/8

Real Red CS: 2 x 4

Azure Afternoon Ink

Memento Black Ink

Crushed Curry Ink

Stampin' Blend Combos: Smoky Slate

Trusty Tools Bundle

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Stampin' Seal Adhesive/Liquid Glue

### Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) at 4¼. Fold and burnish to create card.
2. Cut the card front at an angle: To do this I measured from the bottom right of card from up 2 ¾ " and made a pencil mark. Lay card front flat in cutter lining up the intersection of the score mark with the pencil mark and cut on the diagonal.
3. Repeat with the designer series paper but make your pencil mark at 2-5/8. Attach DSP to card front.
4. Crop the peg board die from the Trusty Tool bundle w/ Pecan Pie CS and attach to card front.
5. Stamp and crop tools as shown in the video and attach to card front.
6. Stamp greeting with Azure Afternoon ink on the Basic White panel and attach to inside.
7. Crop screw and bolts with Smoky Slate CS and add to inside of card. See video for details.



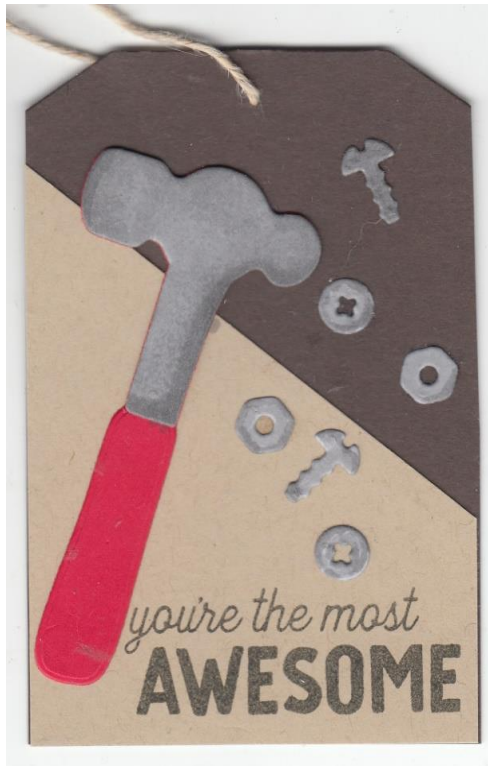

## Make It Monday #141 Trusty Tools Project Sheet



### Trusty Tools Gift Tag

Early Espresso CS-2 ½ x 3 ¾

Crumb Cake CS- 2 ½ x 3-1/8

Smoky Slate CS- 3 x 4

Real Red CS: 1 x 3

Early Espresso Ink

Stampin' Blend Combos: Smoky Slate

Trusty Tools Bundle

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Stampin' Seal Adhesive/Liquid Glue

### Directions

1. Use dies from Trusty Tools Bundle to create tag-See video for details.
2. Cut Crumb Cake CS on the diagonal. I placed my pencil mark at 1-1/8 from the bottom. Add to tag.
3. Crop the hammer head and bolts from Smoky Slate CS and add to Tag. I used the Smoky Slate Blends to add a bit of dimension to the hammer and the bolts.
4. Stamp greeting w/ Early Espresso Ink.
5. Punch small hole in top of tag and add twine or linen thread.
