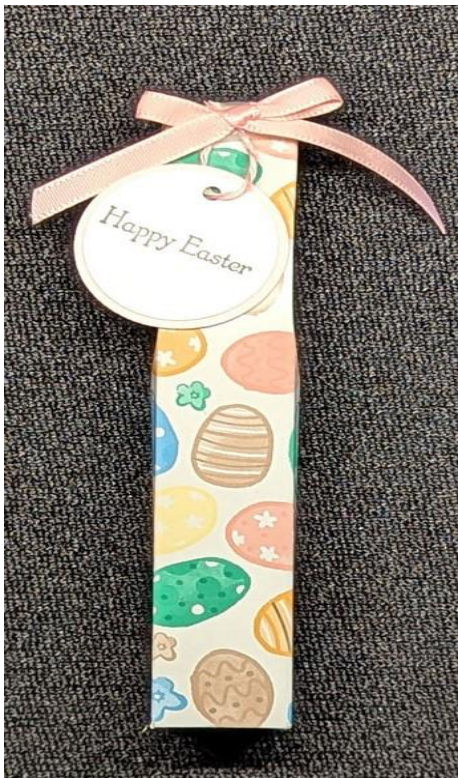

#### Card # 1-Happy Easter

Easter Joy DSP: 4 x 6

Basic White CS- 2 x 2

Bubble Bath CS- 2 ½ x 2 ½

Teeny Tiny Wishes stamp set (retired)

Memento Black Ink

Pink ribbon-bow for tag

Liquid glue, Tear and Tape, or Stampin' Seal Plus

Bone Folder

1 ¼ " circle punch

1 3/8" circle punch

Small hole punch and twice for tag

#### Directions

1. Score 4 x 6 in portrait position with directional pattern at the top. Score at 7/8, 1¾, 2-5/8, and 3 ½. Rotate ¼ turn making sure the directional pattern is to the left and score at 5-1/8.
2. Miter the ½" edge and cut up to score lines to create tabs. (see video for details)
3. Use a bone folder to fold and burnish on all score lines. Add adhesive to ½ inch tab. (see video for details)
4. Fold and glue tabs to create bottom of box.
5. Fill box with treats of choice and pinch top of box closed. Use a stapler to close opening.
6. Create tag with circle punches and add to top of box to hide staple.





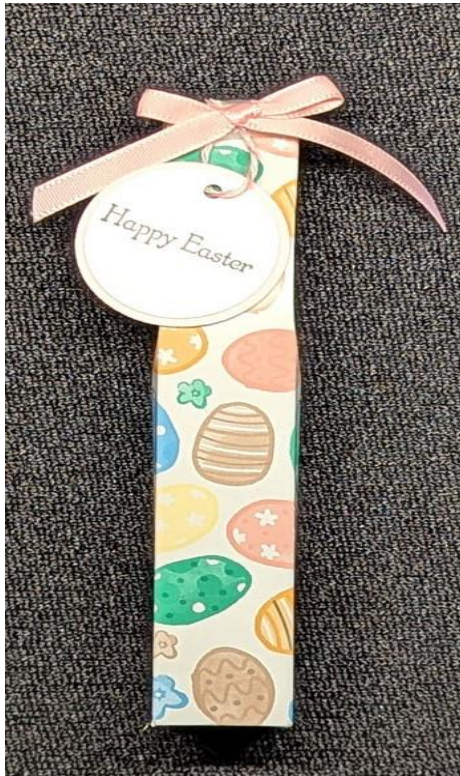

#### Directions to create 6 boxes 12 x 12 DSP

Easter Joy or Designer Series paper of choice: 12 x 12

If you have a directional pattern, be sure the top is facing up to the top of your scoring tool.

I like to score my paper with the pattern I want to show for my box face down from me.

Score at  $7/8$ ,  $1\ 3/4$ ,  $2\ 5/8$ ,  $3\ 1/2$ ,  $4\ 7/8$ ,  $5\ 3/4$ ,  $6\ 5/8$ ,  $7\ 1/2$ ,  $8\ 7/8$ ,  $9\ 3/4$ ,  $10\ 5/8$ , and  $11\ 1/2$ .

Rotate your paper to the left one  $1/4$  turn making sure the top of your pattern is facing the left.

Score at  $5\ 1/8$  and  $6\ 7/8$ . Cut on this side of paper at 6". This will create two 6 x 12 piece.

Cut each piece into 4" sections, giving you 6 box templates.

**NOTE:** if you are cutting both pieces of 6 X 12 at once, be sure to line up the  $1/2$ " sections together before cutting.
