Card #1-Happy Birthday

Bubble Bath CS -5 ½ x 8 ½; Score at 4¼

Summer Splash CS-4-7/8 x 5-3/8

Basic White CS- 4 x 5 ¼ (2)

Masking Paper

Natural Botanicals stamp set

With You In Mind stamp set

Summer Splash Ink

Pool Party Ink

Bubble Bath Ink

Blending Brushes

Liquid glue

Bling of Choice

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Use the Masking Paper to tape off diagonal section in middle of Basic White panel.
3. Use Blending Brushes to add Pool Party and Bubble Bath ink to white panel and then randomly stamp large leaf in Pool Party, small leaf in Summer Splash and flower in Bubble Bath ink on white panel.
4. Gently remove masking paper and stamp greeting with Summer Splash ink and attach to card front.
5. Add bling of choice to card front.
6. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired.



Card # 2-Thinking of You

Highland Heather CS: 5 ½ x 8 ½ ; Score at 4 ¼

Gorgeous Grape CS: 3-7/8 x 5-1/8

Basic White: 3 ¾ x 5, 4 x 5 ¼

Masking Paper or printer paper

Friendly Foliage stamp set

Country Corner Dies

Highland Heather Ink

Gorgeous Grape Ink

Blending Brush

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Liquid Glue

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Use Country Corner die to crop a mask from masking paper or scrap white printer paper.
3. Place mask over 4 x 5 ¼ Basic White panel. If using printer paper, secure with positional tape.
4. Use Blending Brush to add Highland Heather color to the inside of mask.
5. Stamp two wheat images on the bottom of mask before removing as shown. See video for details.
6. Gently remove masking paper and stamp remaining images and greeting with Gorgeous Grape ink.
7. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired.

Card # 3-Happy Birthday

Pretty in Pink CS: 5 ½ x 8 ½; Score at 4 ¼

Basic White CS: 3 ¾ x 5, 4 x 5 ¼

Smoky Slate CS: 4 x 5 ¼

Charming Day stamp set

The Right Words stamp set

Pretty in Pink Ink

Blending Brush

Colored pencil-yellow

Masking Paper

Liquid Glue

Stampin' Dimensionals

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Randomly stamp three flowers in the center of card front. Create a mask for flowers and cover stamped image.
3. Use Blending Brush to gently add Pretty Pink ink in a circular motion around masked flower. Repeat for other two flower images and gently remove masks.
4. Randomly stamp more flowers to cover Basic White panel and attach to card front.
5. Color center of flower with colored pencil, marker, or alcohol blends.
6. Stamp greeting on small strip of white with Memento Black ink and add to card front using Dimensionals.
7. Add Basic White to inside and decorate as desired.
