Card #1 Sorry for Your Loss

Calypso Coral CS-5 ½ x 8 ½; Score at 4¼

Crushed Curry CS: 4 x 5 ¼

Basic White CS: 1 ¼ x 2-1/8, 4 x 5 ¼, 3-7/8 x 5-1/8

Designer Series Paper of choice: 1 x 2 (13-14)

Inks: Memento Black or Color to coordinate w/DSP/ card base

Stamps: Prayers and Promises

Swirled Magic Embossing Folder

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Liquid glue

Stampin' Dimensionals

Corner Rounder punch

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Attach 1 x 3" pieces of DSP to 3-7/8 x 5-1/8 panel. Trim off excess and attach to Crushed Curry panel and then to card front as shown. Depending on your DSP choice, your colors may be different.
3. Dry emboss patchwork panel with embossing folder of choice. I used the Swirled Magic.
4. Stamp greeting of Basic White panel. Use corner rounder punch on all edges and then attach to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired.





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Card #2-Get Well Soon

Petal Pink CS -5 ½ x 8 ½; Score at 4¼, 3-7/8 x 5-1/8

DSP of choice: Lovely and Beautiful: 1 x 2 (13-14)

Basic White CS: ¾ x 2 ¾

Old Olive CS: 4 x 5 ¼

Stamps: Friendly Foliage

Inks: Memento Black or Secret Sea

Paper Snips

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Embossing Folder of Choice

Black Journaling Pen:

Liquid glue

Sequins or bling to match DSP

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Attach 1 x 3" pieces of DSP to 3-7/8 x 5-1/8 panel. Trim off excess and cut down to 3 ¾ x 5.
3. Use black journaling marker to draw stitch lines around faux patches.
4. Dry emboss patchwork panel with embossing folder of choice.
5. Add patchwork panel to Petal Pink and Old Olive panels and then to card front.
6. Stamp greeting of Basic White panel. Use paper snips to create a banner and attach to card front.
7. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired





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Card #3-Thinking of You

Night of Navy CS -5 ½ x 8 ½; Score at 4¼

Basic White CS: ½ x 2 ¼, 3-7/8 x 5-1/8 (2), 4 x 5¼

DSP of choice: 1 x2 (13-14)

Stamps: Friendly Foliage

Inks: Night of Navy

Liquid glue

Journaling pen to match DSP

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Attach 1 x 3" pieces of DSP to 3-7/8 x 5-1/8 panel. Trim off excess and cut down to 3 ¾ x 5.
3. Use journaling marker to draw stitch lines around faux patches.
4. Add patchwork panel to Basic White panel and then to card front.
5. Stamp greeting of Basic White panel and attach to card front.
6. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired
