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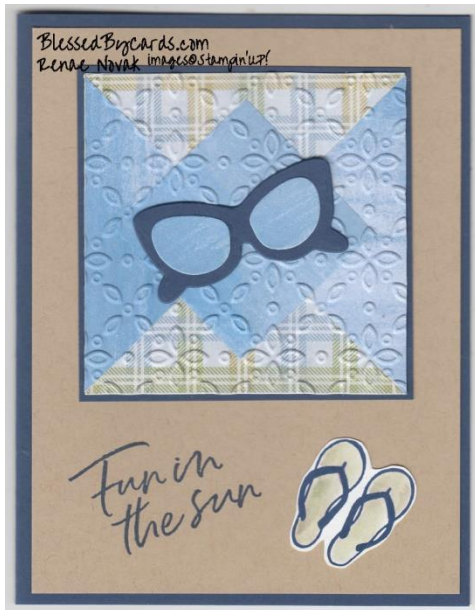

Card #1 Fun in the Sun

Night of Navy CS-5½ x 8½; Score at 4¼, 1½ x 2¼, 3-1/8 x 3-1/8

Crumb Cake CS: 4 x 5¼

Basic White CS: 1½ x 1½, 4 x 5¼, 3 x 3

Designer Series Paper of choice: 3 x 3 (1 or 2), 1 ¾ x 1 ¾

Inks: Night of Navy or Color to coordinate w/DSP/ card base

Stamps: Summer Happiness Bundle

Embossing Folder of choice: Eyelet (pictured)

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Liquid glue

Paper Snips

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Attach Crumb Cake panel to card front.
3. Cut one 3 x 3 square of DSP that coordinates on both side, or cut two 3 x 3 coordinating DSP panels. Cut each on the diagonal-see video for details.
4. You will only need 2 triangles, one from each pattern. Cut each triangle in half by placing the long edge at the top of your cutter and center the point of your triangle into the track of your paper cutter.
5. You should now have 4 triangles, two of each DSP pattern.
6. Layer the triangles onto a 3 x 3 piece of white cardstock or printer paper. See video for details.
7. Glue small triangle to the center of patchwork design and emboss with folder of choice.
8. Attach quilted block to 3-1/8 x 3-1/8 solid panel and attach to card front as shown.
9. Stamp greeting and add additional embellishments as desired.
10. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired.





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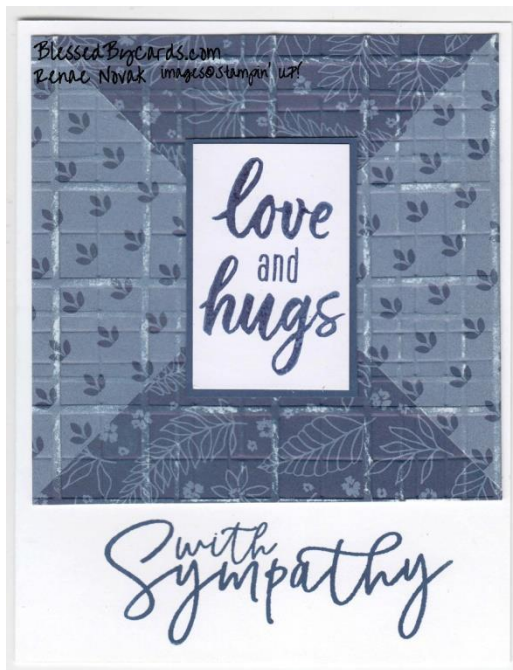
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Card #2-With Sympathy

Basic White CS -5 1/2 x 8 1/2; Score at 4 1/4, 4 x 4, 1-3/8 x 2-1/8

DSP of choice: 4 x 4 (2) coordinating patterns

Night of Navy CS: 1 1/2 x 2 1/4

Stamps: Greenery Lane

Inks: Night of Navy

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Embossing Folder of Choice: Forever plaid (pictured)

Liquid glue

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4 1/4. Fold and burnish card.
2. Cut one 4 x 4 square of DSP that coordinates on both side, or cut two 4 x 4 coordinating DSP panels. Cut each on the diagonal-see video for details.
3. You will only need 2 triangles, one from each pattern. Cut each triangle in half by placing the long edge at the top of your cutter and center the point of your triangle into the track of your paper cutter.
4. You should now have 4 triangles, two of each DSP pattern.
5. Layer the triangles onto a 4 x 4 piece of white cardstock or printer paper. See video for details.
6. Stamp greeting on Basic White panel. Attach to Night of Navy panel and then to card front as shown.
7. Stamp sympathy greeting w/Night of Navy ink to bottom of card under the quilting block design.
8. Decorate the inside as desired.





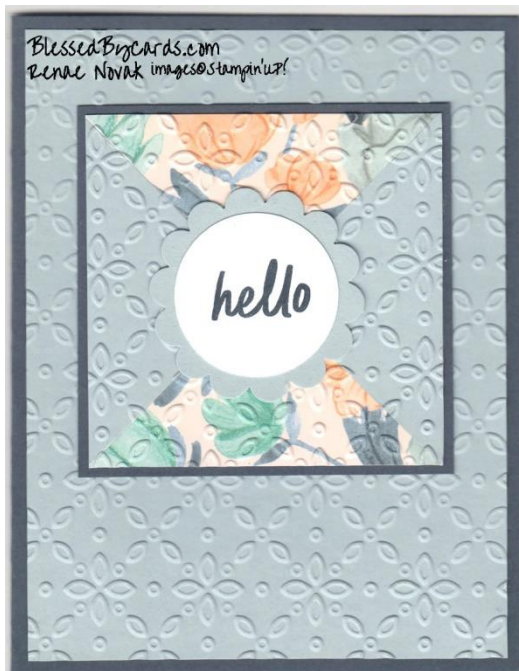
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Card #3-Hello

Secret Sea CS-5½ x 8½; Score at 4¼, 3-1/8 x 3-1/8

Cloud Cover CS: 4 x 5¼, 2 x 2, 3 x 3

Basic White CS: 2 x 2, 4 x 5¼, 3 x 3

Designer Series Paper of choice: 3 x 3

Inks: Secret Sea

Stamps: Simply Said

Embossing Folder of choice: Eyelet (pictured)

Stampin' Cut n Emboss Machine

Liquid glue

1 ¾ inch scallop punch

1-3/8 inch circle punch

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Emboss Cloud Cover panel with embossing folder of choice and attach to card front.
3. Cut DSP and Cloud Cover square on the diagonal. You will only need 2 triangles, one from DSP and one from Cloud Cover CS. Cut each triangle in half.
5. You should now have 4 triangles, two of the DSP pattern and two from the Cloud Cover cardstock.
6. Layer the triangles onto a 3 x 3 piece of white cardstock or printer paper. See video for details.
7. Emboss square with folder of choice and attach to 3-1/8 x 3-1/8 Secret Sea panel and then to card front.
8. Use 1 ¾" scallop circle punch or die to crop cloud cover circle. Use 1-3/8" circle punch to crop white circle. Stamp greeting w/Secret Sea ink and attach to scallop circle and then to card front as shown.
9. Add Basic White panel to the inside and decorate as desired.
