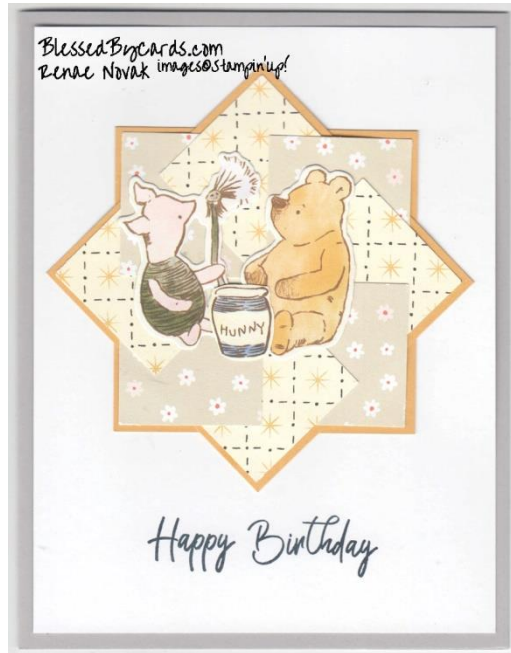

Make It Monday #271 Quilting w/Paper Part 3: Pinwheel Card

Card # 1- Blessings

Smoky Slate CS -5 ½ x 8 ½ ; Score at 4¼,

Basic White CS: 4 x 5 ¼ (2),

Golden Glow CS: 2-5/8 x 2-5/8 (2)

DSP: Silly Old Bear -1¼ x 1¼ (8)

Inks: Memento Black or Secret Sea

Stamps: Rolling Waves

Snail Adhesive and Liquid glue

1 1/4" square punch

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Create a star with your 2 pieces of 2-5/8 x 2-5/8, see video for details.
3. Add squares of DSP to all points on the star, see video for details. TIP: It is important to only use a small amount of glue on each square until the very last square is attached.
4. Add Basic White panel to card front and then add quilted pinwheel.
5. Stamp greeting on cards front as shown.
6. Add Basic White CS to the inside and decorate as desired.





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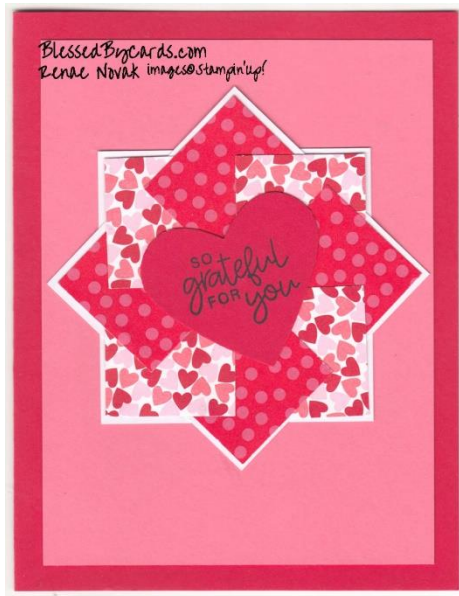
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Card #2- So Grateful for You

Real Red CS -5 ½ x 8 ½ ; Score at 4¼,

Basic White CS: 4 x 5 ¼, 2-5/8 x 2-5/8 (2)

Flirty Flamingo CS: 4 x 5 ¼

DSP: Made With Love -1¼ x 1¼ (8)

Inks: Memento Black or Secret Sea

Stamps: Lily of the Valley

Snail Adhesive and Liquid glue

1 1/4" square punch

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Create a star with your 2 pieces of 2-5/8 x 2-5/8, see video for details.
3. Add squares of DSP to all points on the star, see video for details. TIP: It is important to only use a small amount of glue on each square until the very last square is attached.
4. Crop heart and stamp greeting from Lily of the Valley. Attach heart to center of pinwheel patch.
5. Add Flirty Flamingo to card front. Add pinwheel patchwork to card front as shown.
6. Add Basic White CS to the inside and decorate as desired.





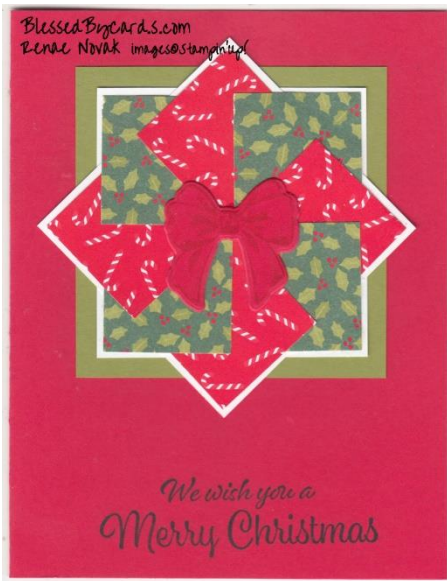
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Card #3- Merry Christmas

Real Red CS -5 ½ x 8 ½ ; Score at 4¼,
Basic White CS: 4 x 5 ¼, 2-5/8 x 2-5/8 (2)
Old Olive CS: 3 x 3
DSP: A Stitched Season -1¼ x 1¼ (8)
Inks: Memento Black or Secret Sea
Stamps: Elegantly Wrapped Bundle (coming Sept 2026)
Snail Adhesive and Liquid glue
Glue Dots
1 1/4" square punch

Directions

1. Score card base in landscape position (aka longer side) in half at 4¼. Fold and burnish card.
2. Create a star with your 2 pieces of 2-5/8 x 2-5/8, see video for details.
3. Add squares of DSP to all points on the star, see video for details. TIP: It is important to only use a small amount of glue on each square until the very last square is attached.
4. Add pinwheel patchwork to Old Olive CS and then to card front.
5. Crop bow from Real Red CS using the dies from the new Elegantly Wrapped Bundle (coming in Sept 2026)
6. Add Wink of Stella to bow for a bit of sparkle and add to card front using glue dots.
7. Add Basic White CS to the inside and decorate as desired.
